Guidelines

Overview

In my role as your local State Member, I am always pleased to support local community groups and individuals through donations. To help create a more transparent donation process, I have started my Local Hero Grants, which are designed to provide small donations to not-for-profit community groups and individuals from the Buderim Electorate. Four grants of up to \$250 each will be available through three rounds each year. They aim to provide financial support for local groups who support our community and to individuals needing assistance to travel to sporting/other competitions or events.

Who can apply?

1. Not-for-profit community groups based in the Buderim Electorate. Groups do not need to be incorporated but must have been in operation for at least one year.
2. Individuals aged 10 years and over who have been selected for zone, state or international sporting/cultural/other events. Individuals must be a resident of the Buderim Electorate.

How often can a group or individual apply?

Eligible groups can submit one application per round. If this application is successful, only one application is permitted within the twelve-month timeframe.

How much can a group apply for?

Applications are \$250 each (including GST). Four successful applications will be chosen in each round.

Application Rounds

There will be three rounds per year with closing dates for 2024 as follows:

- Thursday 28 March
- Friday 28 June
- Friday 27 September

Successful groups will be notified approximately two weeks following the closing date.
